**OF SPECIAL NOTE:** We will not be bringing everything on this list so a Pre-Order will reserve the plant – in addition, we will be bringing some first bloom One-of-a-Kind seedlings grown from flasks purchased from select cutting-edge breeding programs in Taiwan including Brother Orchids, Tying Shin Orchids, Hsia Orchids, Lyndon Orchids & Mainshow Orchids.

At various times during the year, this will also include plants of *Phal. bellina*, *Phal. violacea* and hybrids with their breeding background. These will be available on a First Come-First Serve basis – all will be One-of-a-Kind plants, not mericlones.

We've also expanded our collection of miniature **Chinese Cymbidiums**, miniature **Vandaceous** and miniature **Dendrobiums** – all of which grow & flower happily with our Phals. We have now listed these in their very own sections.

All plants are in 3" – or smaller - pots unless otherwise noted

*Charming rare color form of this micro-miniature Phalaenopsis species !  
Multitudes of small yellow flowers are produced in abundance on compact branching spikes, often pendulous, over equally compact leaves. The perfect little species, easily tucked into any collection !*

*The rare alba form of Phal. hieroglyphica which we find much more charming than the common white & burgundy form. For an alba form these have been extremely vigorous growers & a few from this group have flowered already. Always leave the previously flowered spike on the plant since they do tend to add additional buds while making a new spike or two.*

Very compact pendulous spikes produce small flowers cascading over or between compact round leaves. Unfortunately, many plants found their way into this country mislabeled as Phal. mariae when they were actually Phal. bastianii. Phal. mariae is easily recognized by its gently cascading flower spikes and bold blotching on its creamy-white waxy flowers. We've already flowered a few from this population last July &amp; it is the <b>TRUE</b> Phal. mariae. A spring bloomer, it can produce 6-8 flowers which cascade over its pendulous leaves. Grow in a slightly more shaded location, with warm to intermediate temperatures. The pod parent is a delightfully spotted beautifully round flower, but we found the spike and plant habit just too large. However, by crossing it to Phal. amabilis, the plant and flower size has been reduced to a more compact display and footprint – very much like having a miniature form of Phal. Acker's Sweetie. Now that they are all in flower, we are sure that they cloned just like the parent since all the buds were triangular in form. A slow grower &amp; slow to open its flowers – but well worth the wait !
