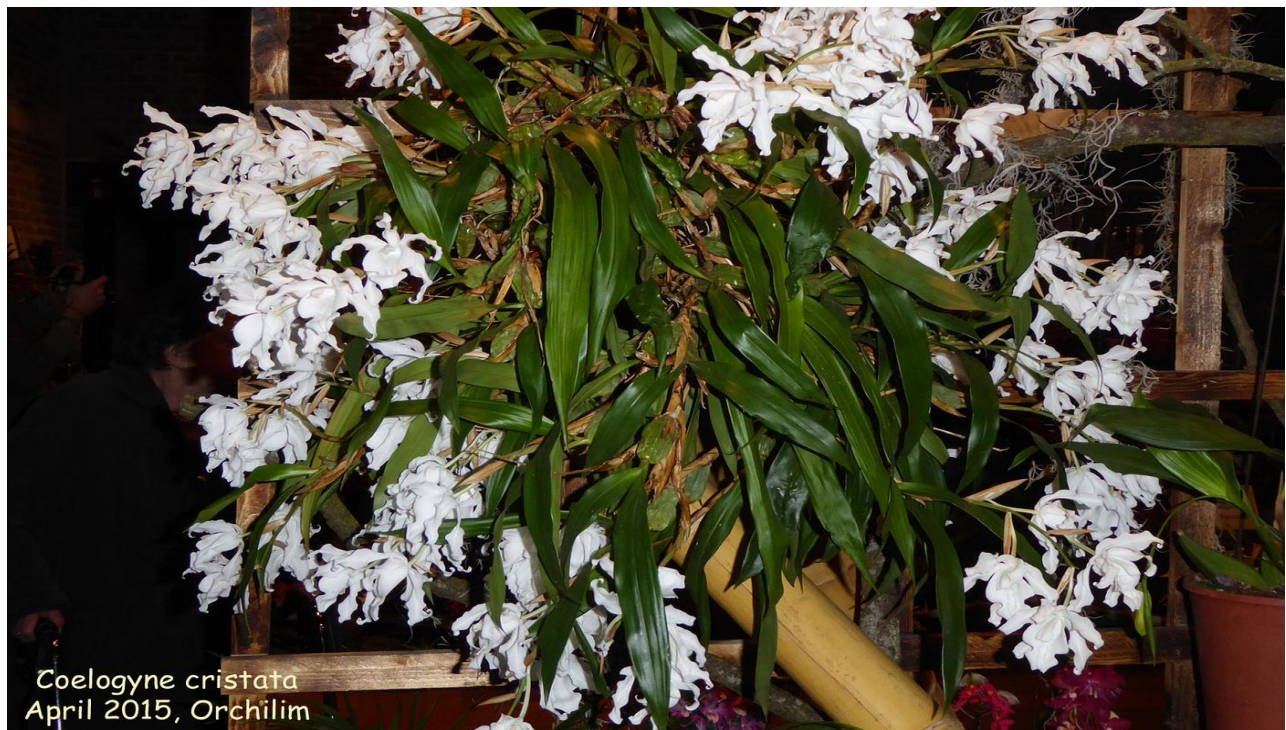
### June

## Member's Choice for March Orchid of the Month-

Grown by George Newman

The “Members Choice “ plant is *Coelogyne cristata* var. *alba* and had 96 flowers . It was purchased from J and L nursery in 2005 as a small plant. Since then it has grown into 2 large specimens . The plant shown at the meeting is growing in a large clay pot in a bark mix. Most of the year it is grown in a cool greenhouse in good light and kept drier in the winter. In summers the plants are outside on the east side of my house and watered more often . I use R. O. water and fertilize with MSU pure water during active growth The species is native to the eastern Himalayan mountains to Vietnam..... George
